Cob Ripeness



Erect tapered blocky cob with 32 rows of grain and 14 grains per ring. Good grain maturity on challenging fields.

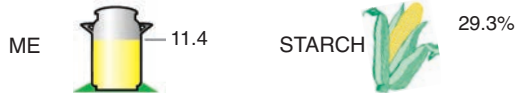
Cob ripening days after Picker + 10

Maturity Group



In the main maturity group required by most growers, Absalon has good grain maturity and large cob driving starch production. Plant remains green at harvest increasing harvest window for chopping.

Quality & Digestibility



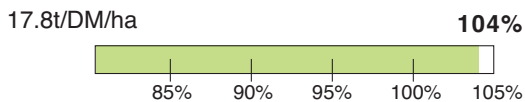
Superb digestibility, 58.6% CWD highest on the Less Favourable DL, drives ME allowing more maize to be fed and more milk or meat to be produced. High starch yields per hectare.

Plant Description



Very consistent medium height plant with large blocky cob. Erect wide green leaves forming a very leafy canopy.

Yield



Sow at 42,500 to 45,000 seeds per acre (105,000 to 111,000 seeds/ha) to maximise output. High yield for an early variety across four very contrasting years. Superior cob and grain content proportion in the clamp. Balanced quality characteristics.
