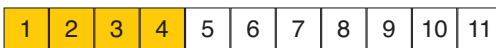
Cob Ripeness

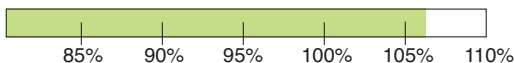
Very tall plant with very wide erect leaves. Looks good in field.

Tested in new NIAB 3rd Cut Trials where long season varieties FAO 220+ have been tested on the best sites. Watson was the third highest yielding variety in the trial series with excellent lodging resistance.
