Cob Ripeness



Well filled indeterminate cob with excellent cob ripeness. Early starch lay down in the grain. Big cob with a lot of grain. Cob ripening days after Picker + 2

Maturity Group



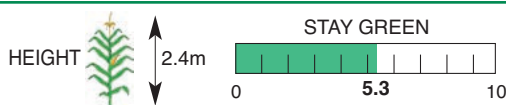
Very early Maturity Group 11 variety with fast leaf dry down at harvest.

Quality & Digestibility



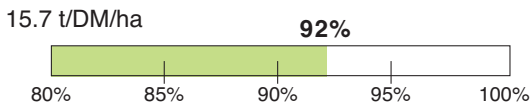
Good yield of ME 176,000 Mj/ha and high starch yield of 5.2t/ha. Ardent ensures mature maize is clamped in the pit.

Plant Description



Tall plant with erect leaves and good standing. Quick dry down at harvest as sugars in the leaf are moved to starch in the grain. Good resistance to eyespot in NIAB trials.

Yield



Sow at 42,500 to 45,000 seeds per acre (105,000 to 111,000 seeds/ha) to maximise output. Excellent yields for Ultra Early Variety. Robust variety with good combination of cob maturity and plant dry down.
