### Cob Ripeness



8.5 mean

Very early maturing grain on a thin spindle. Distinctive long indeterminate cob. Better cob maturity in marginal areas than Kaspian or Ambition.

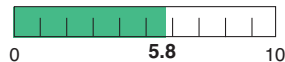
### Plant Description

Good vigour (7.8) in the spring. Tall erect plant.  
Improved quality in a very early variety due to even plant dry down and good cob maturity.

### Yield

16.5 t/DM/ha

Sow at 42,500 to 45,000 seeds per acre (105,000 to 111,000 seeds/ha) to maximise output. High yielding group 10 variety. Good combination of yield and maturity. Very reliable performance in field.
