Cob Ripeness



Long erect indeterminate cob with large flat grains. Early starch lay down in the grain.

Cob ripening days after Picker + 3

Maturity Group



Fast natural maturity from mature cob. Good disease resistance.

Quality & Digestibility



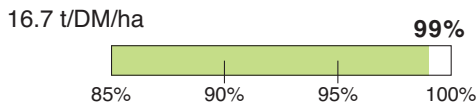
Good combination of cob ripeness and leaf dry down combine for quality silage. Early starch lay down ensures early harvest.

Plant Description



Medium tall plant with erect green leaves. Good vigour (7.1) for establishment in the Spring.

Yield



Sow at 42,500 to 45,000 seeds per acre (105,000 to 111,000 seeds/ha) to maximise output. High yields for Ultra early maturing variety. Strong plant with high leaf bulk and good cobs combine to fill the clamp with quality forage.
