Maturity Group



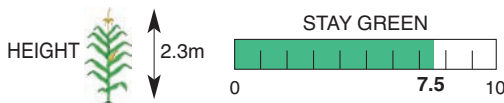
Bonnie is a maturity class 8 variety for the main bulk of maize growers. Its early cob ripeness allows high yields of forage to be achieved even in areas with less heat units.

Quality & Digestibility



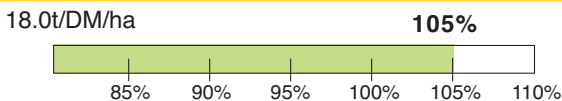
Very high digestibility and cell wall digestibility combine with good starch to produce superb silage.

Plant Description



Excellent early vigour and early season growth. Medium height plant with low cob attachment ensuring very good lodging resistance.

Yield



Sow at 42,500 to 45,000 seeds per acre (105,000 to 111,000 seeds/ha) to maximise output. Very high yields of forage in NIAB trials. Excellent combination of cob and plant yield to form quality forage in the clamp.
