

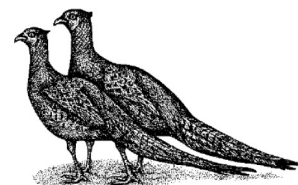

Gamecover seed 2014



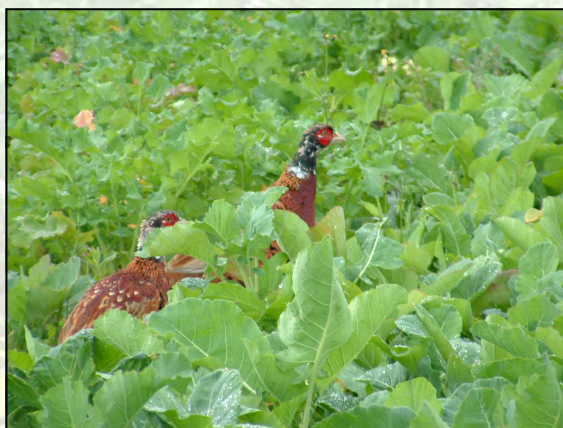
Gamecover Guide

- With soil temperatures rising and spring crops starting to be drilled around the country now is the time to start thinking about gamecover seed options for the 2014/15 season.
- Whether you are a professional gamekeeper or just putting in some cover for a few days on the farm then attention to detail and careful choices are vital to providing good sport for all.
- Whatever cover crops you decide upon care must be taken to provide good ground conditions and seedbeds, correct amount of fertiliser and sow at the correct time and seed rate.
- Producing stale seedbeds will help with weed control to improve the potential of the cover crop being sown.

Stale seedbed technique

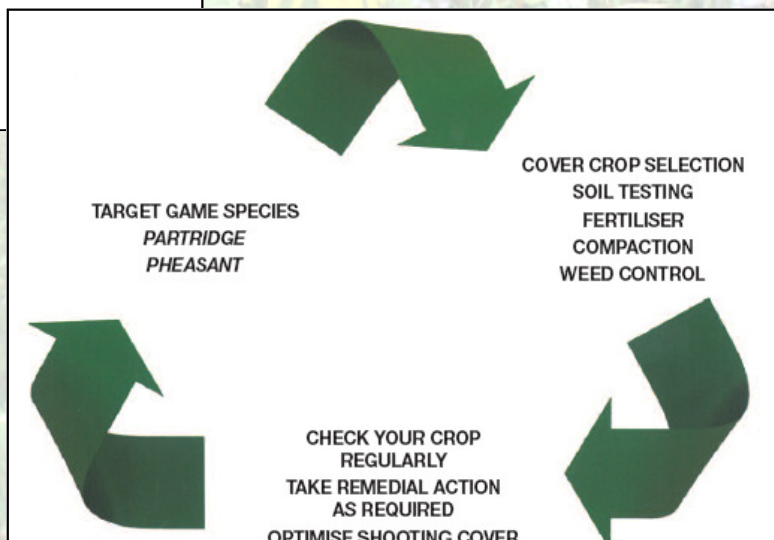
The technique of stale seedbed allows the weeds to germinate prior to sowing and then to be sprayed off (this may need to be done twice).

- Destroy existing crop or cover
- Spray weeds and plough
- Work down into a seedbed with good tilth
- Allow weeds to germinate and spray with a suitable herbicide
- Drill new cover crop when correct conditions prevail.
